

# About Patna



**Gol Ghat**

The Golghar or Gol Ghar, ("Round House") is a large granary located to the west of the Gandhi Maidan in Patna, capital city of Bihar state, India. According to a contemporary inscription at its base, the Golghar in Patna was intended to be just the first of a series of huge grain stores. In the end, however, no others were ever build. The granary was "part of a general plan ... for the perpetual prevention of famine in these provinces. The beehive - shaped structure was designed by John Garstin of the Bengal Engineers, part of the East India Company's Bengal Army. Its construction was completed on 20 July 1786.



**Gurdwara, Patna Sahib**

Takht Sri Patna Sahib also known as Harmandir Sahib, is a Gurdwara in the neighbourhood of Patna Sahib, India. It was to commemorate the birthplace of Guru Gobind Singh, the tenth Guru of the Sikhs on December 1666. It was built by Maharaja Ranjit Singh (1780-1839), the first Maharaja of the Sikh Empire, who also built many other Gurdwaras in the Indian subcontinent. The current shrine of Patna Sahib or Takht Sri Harmandirji Sahib was built in the 1950s. Guru Gobind Singh, the tenth Sikh Guru, was born in Patna, Bihar, on 22 December 1666.



**Patna Secretariate**

Patna Secretariat, also known as Patna Sachivalaya or Old Secretariat, is the administrative headquarters of the state Government of Bihar in India. It is located in Bihar's capital city of Patna. Patna Secretariat is a mighty Victorian construction located to the east of the Raj Bhavan in Patna. Built by the British in the Indo-Sarcentic style, it was completed in 1917. It is 716 feet long 364 feet wide and remains one of the largest government buildings of the city. A huge clock tower stands tall amidst the beautiful and green lawn of the place. Originally, it was 198 feet high, but a part of it fell down during the - 1934 NepalBihar earthquake. Currently its height is 184 feet from the ground.



**Patna Mahavir Temple**

Mahavir Mandir in Patna is a renowned temple dedicated to Lord Hanuman, located near Patna Junction. It's a popular pilgrimage site known for its spiritual significance and the belief that Sankat Mochan (Hanuman) fulfills devotees' wishes. The temple is also known for its famous Naivedyam Laddu Prasad. The temple is believed to have been established by Swami Balanand of the Ramanandi sect around 1730 AD. The Patna High Court officially recognized its historical value in 1948, acknowledging its long-standing existence. It is considered a symbol of devotion and spiritual faith, attracting numerous devotees daily.



**Mahatma Gandhi Setu Bridge**

Mahatma Gandhi Setu (also called Gandhi Setu or Ganga Setu) is a bridge over the river Ganga in Bihar, India connecting Patna in the south to Hajipur in the north. Its length of 5,750 metres (18,860 ft) makes it the fourth-longest river bridge in India. It was inaugurated in May 1982 in a ceremony in Hajipur by then-prime minister Indira Gandhi. From 1982 to 2017, Mahatma Gandhi Setu was the longest bridge in India. Later, the Gandhi Setu rehabilitation project was undertaken to install triangular steel trusses on Mahatma Gandhi Setu. In recent decades, the bridge has experienced major traffic chaos due to the increasing number of vehicles crossing it, operating in excess of capacity and overloading the structure. In 2014, Bihar government announced plans to build two pontoon bridges parallel to Gandhi Setu, in order to relieve congestion problems. One pontoon bridge was opened in 2017. The bridge is crossed daily by over 85,000 vehicles and 12,000 pedestrians. On 21 September 2020, Prime Minister Mr Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone of another 4-lane road bridge measuring 14.5 km and will cost 2926.42 crores It will be on the west side of the present bridge, and in the future, it will become 8 lane bridge including the present 4 lane bridge.

Dr Das is the Vice Chairman Emeritus of the L V Prasad Eye Institute. He is Professor of Ophthalmology at the Sun Yet-Sen University, Guangzhou, China; and Adjunct Professor of Ophthalmology at University of Rochester Medical School, Rochester, NY, USA; and Fellow, National Academy of Medical Sciences, India.

The current leadership positions of Dr Das include: Regional Chair, International Agency for Prevention of Blindness (IAPB) Southeast Asia; President, Asia Pacific Vitreo- Retinal Society (APVRS); Member, Research Committee, Asia Pacific Academy of Ophthalmology (APAO); Associate Editor, Asia Pacific Journal of Ophthalmology (APJO); Member, Editorial Board, Ophthalmic Research; Member, International Council of Ophthalmology (ICO) Ophthalmology Specialty (Vitreoretina) Training; Chairman, Ethics Committee, Indian Institute of Public Health (IIPH); Member of Board, VISION 2020 India; Member, Advisory Committee, 13th Five Year Plan, Government of India; and Member, Member Task Force, Diabetic Retinopathy, Government of India, and Mentor, Leadership Development Program, Asia Pacific Vitreo- Retinal Society.

He is also former President of All India Ophthalmological Society (AIOS) and Vitreo Retinal Society of India (VRSI), and the Chairman, Program committee (Retina), Association of Research in Vision and Ophthalmology (ARVO), USA. The Indian Journal of Ophthalmology (IJO) celebrated the golden jubilee when he was the Editor-in-Chief of the journal.


